

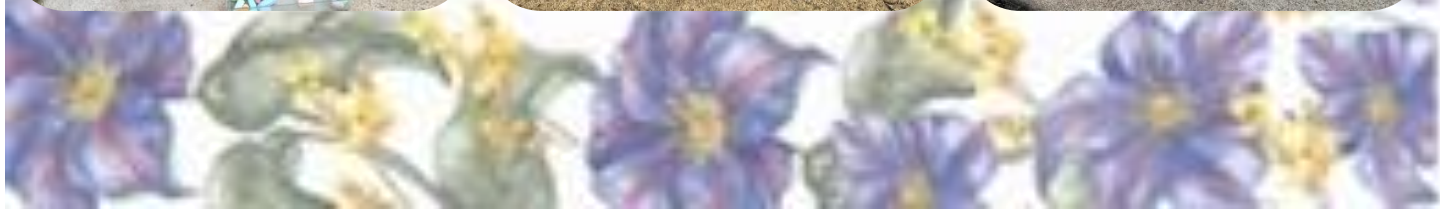
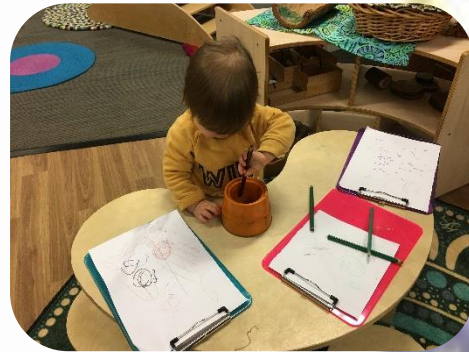
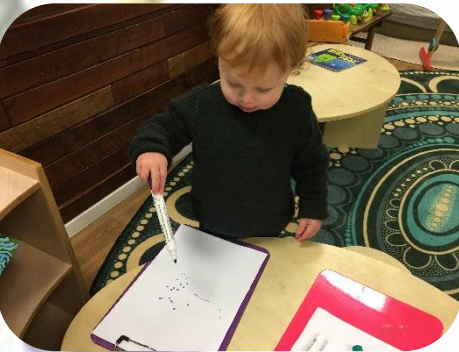

Alden: moved around to each container while saying “more! More!”

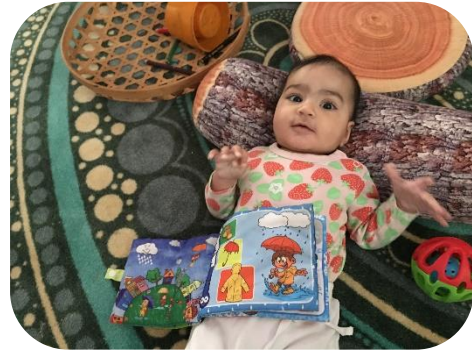
Fred: Expressed his ideas by stamping the paintbrush on the concrete repeatedly.
